About this Catalogue

The items in this catalogue are based on a Mental Health Commission of Canada (MHCC) environmental scan of resources and programs targeted toward postvention. Postvention refers to suicide prevention activities to support people impacted by suicide (e.g., those bereaved after suicide loss). These activities are crucial for helping those affected and for reducing the risk of further suicides or crises. Examples include followup education, peer support, employee assistance programs, counselling, etc.¹ Note: The resources listed are for information purposes only. They are not meant to be exhaustive or be taken to represent an endorsement by the MHCC.
